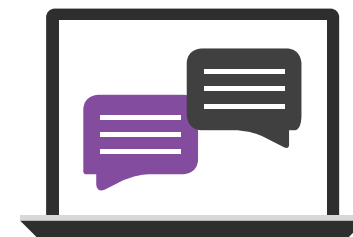

How does YourTutor work?

Typed chat. Students write back and forth with the tutor in an environment they're comfortable with.



Interactive whiteboard. Draw in real-time with the tutor, so it's easy to discuss graphs and equations.



File upload. Send a draft writing file (essays, speeches, creative writing, reports) to a tutor for detailed, expert feedback on how to make it even better.

What subjects can we get help with?

All core curricula subjects. Students studying history or other humanities subjects can get help by selecting 'Research' or 'Writing feedback' depending on their question, even though, for example, 'History' is not visible. English, maths, and the sciences (biology, chemistry and physics) are specifically covered.
