Children nowadays watch significantly more television than those in the past, which reduces their activities levels accordingly. Why is this case?

What measures can you suggest to encourage higher levels of activity among children?

It is undoubtedly true that the majority of children in the modern world prefer watching television to engaging in outdoor activities. Although this arises from several reasons, there are still some solutions to this negative trend.

There are **some** ['Some' refers to an uncertain amount, so you have not used it incorrectly. However, in this context it would sound better if you said, 'a number of main causes' or 'many main causes,' as you are stating that there are a lot of reasons why children watch too much TV but you are only going to address a couple.] main causes of children's bias towards watching television. One main reason is that, [You do not require a comma here as you do not require a pause in the sentence.] as technological products have become cheaper these days, most families have one or more television sets in their houses, which enables young children to watch television routinely. Another critical cause of children's **watching habit** [Not every child will have the exact same TV watching habit as another child so it is best to use the plural form: 'children's TV watching habits.'] is that they lack care from their parents. **Since** ['Since' does mean 'because' however, it makes more sense to say 'AS society becomes....' because you are implying that as society changes so do people's lifestyles.] society becomes **more and more competitive** [It would strengthen your argument to clarify why and how society becomes more and more competitive. Do you mean that finding employment is competitive? Growing a business is competitive? Having a more expensive lifestyle is competitive?], people have to spend most of their time working rather than going home and playing with their young children. This lack of care pushes children to use television as their main **way of entertainment**. [You should say 'form of entertainment'. Also, consider this: parents provide their children with more than just entertainment, such as comfort and interaction. Do you think that TV also provides something more than just entertainment?]

However, parents can encourage outdoor activities by taking **proper actions**. [Think about rephrasing this. I understand what you meant, but it can be expressed better.] Firstly, this can be done by playing sports with children. For example, as young boys often enjoy playing football, at the weekend fathers should take them to the park and play football with them. If parents maintain this routinely, children will establish the habit to play sports regularly. Secondly, it is necessary to limit the time children watch television. Parents should allow their children to watch TV for only one or two hours at the weekend. Finally, parents should explain to their children the harmfulness of watching television excessively and the benefits they can gain when they engage in outdoor activities.

In conclusion, today children tend to watch television excessively because of many reasons. However, if parents take prompt actions, they can still cope with this negative trend among youngsters.
